The Pastor's Corner


This time of year, it is so easy to think about severe weather, particularly tornados. In fact, these particular phenomena, which can be thought of as wildly energetic columns of wind are quite fascinating and horrifying at the same time. The sheer display of raw power and force is seemingly unparalleled and feared for one simple reason: they have the force to change life as we know it in a matter of seconds, given the right force and wind speed.



Pentecost is an amazing occasion as well because we hear about the force of a different wind, though there was a sound that accompanied its arrival not unlike the sound a twister might make. The disciples were all gathered together, and living in fear, as they waited wondering what Jesus was going to do next. Then, that moment of Pentecost arrived. The strong driving wind was the Holy Spirit that was descending upon them mightily, and it vividly appeared above each of their heads as tongues of fire, indicative of the gift that they were receiving. Notice too, that from that moment, life changed in a profound and dramatic way. They immediately went out and began to tell others about Christ in a courageous and bold way. It was almost as if the disciples were completely changed by that strong driving wind. Their life was changed.

As frightening as tornados are, there is no need to be so afraid of the change we receive when the Holy Spirit that comes to us. It does change our spiritual landscape, in a certain sense, but it is not for ruin but for redemption. In that, though, we should wonder: are we allowing the strong driving wind of the Holy Spirit to change us? It is all too easy to remain as things are- but God always wants to move us forward, even with the wind of the Holy Spirit.

May each of us be filled with the strong driving wind, which is not a severe weather event, -. Fr. Belken but rather Jesus's gift of the Holy Spirit..



PASTORAL NOTE: ONE-HANDED RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION- Over the coming weeks, Father is asking that those who must receive the Eucharist with only hand transition to either receiving on the tongue, or in the case that this is not possible, on one hand which is flat and outstretched to receive our Lord, and then is immediately moved to one's mouth to receive. Please do not "pinch" the host to receive it from the minister's hand to receive. Though this may be unfamiliar, it is simply a movement into greater conformity with the instruction of the Church on how to properly receive Holy Communion. Thank you for your attention to this matter, as we continue to renew ourselves in our love for the Holy Eucharist!
