When I was in seminary, one of many jobs I was tasked with was tuning the pipe organ—which was rather tedious since there were thousands of pipes. It isn't terribly difficult per se, once an ear is trained into what it is looking for, but it is very tiresome. After hundreds of pipes blaring loudly in my ears for hours, until they were tuned, the temptation would creep in to get sloppy just to get it done, but that meant I'd miss all sorts of pipes that needed tuned but could potentially be missed if I succumbed to that temptation. The very thing I set out to do would be rendered unsuccessful in my complacent attitude if I did that!

It doesn't take much searching to find all sorts of things that are tedious and can become wearisome if we are not careful. School can be boring, our jobs can load us down with monotony, and even our faith, at times, can even seem to be fraught with the same danger-to become old and familiar, and therefore we start to become drowsy and weary.

The first week of Advent is presenting us with a challenge to start- Be vigilant! Do not become drunken or drowsy! Do not succumb to carousing or the anxieties of daily life! Why? Because each of these things are dangerous, not only to physical life, but to our spiritual lives. If we become burdened by these supposed escapes, eventually a moment of importance will come when our Lord will appear before us. But will we have become too weary to notice? Will we see the Lord when He comes again for us, and will we still be attentive? Or will we be too distracted by all the "stuff" going on in our lives already? Will we be weary, or awake?

Life may be long and arduous- or even monotonous at times- but the end of it can so worth it, if we stay "in tune" with our Lord- and hear His calling to "Be vigilant at all times and pray!"
