A SNOWY SCENE

Whether you enjoy snow or not, there is one thing that we can all admit: it completely changes the landscape. Usually the transformation is quite abrupt! Often, we can experience it as we go to bed: perhaps we see a few snowflakes but the ground is quite bare. The readings for this weekend remind us of a complete and abrupt transition that will happen when Christ appears. Now, Christ coming to us is not exactly like a snowfall where everyone just has it blanket them over and change their life involuntarily. We have to choose to accept this positive change. Yes, many of us are dealing with "mountains" of difficult situations in our lives. Perhaps we are looking at a valley of sadness, wondering if we will ever make it out. Maybe it just seems like the twists and turns of life are dizzying and confusing. If we allow Christ to enter in- and make Him first priority in our life- He will change it. He has promised, and He will do it.

It's not just snow that has the power to change and make things beautiful. Christ can rescue us and change our lives where we are, in all the twists, turns, mountains, and the valleys we experience. May we allow the sweet snow of Christ to enter in and change our lives for the better- and the more beautiful. Make Him a priority- and He can do something beautiful with your life.
